

Paper Piece Star Stuffy

Basting the Shapes

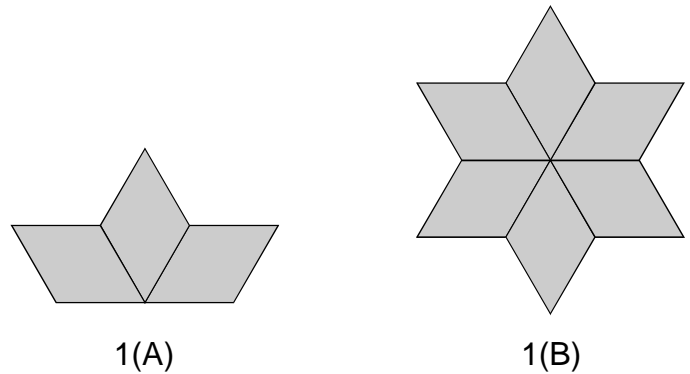
Baste twelve 2" diamonds in fabric.

Stitching the Pieces Together

Take three basted diamonds and whip stitch them together to make block as shown in Figure 1(A). Make two blocks like Figure 1(A).

Take two blocks like Figure 1(A) and whip stitch them together to make star as shown in Figure 1(B).

Whip Stitch the other six diamonds in the same manner.

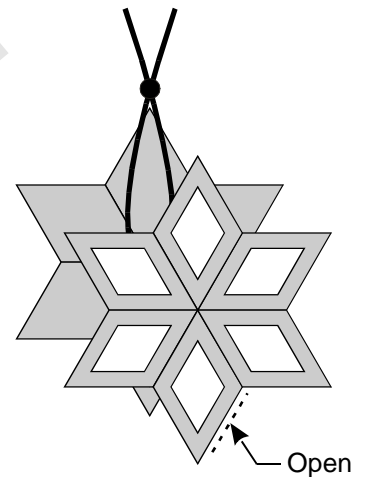


Making the Loop

Tie a loop in a 1/8" wide ribbon as show in Figure 2.

Making the Stuffy

Lay the right sides together and start whip stitching around the edge. Leave an opening along one edge. Make sure that you do the point of that edge. Do not forget to add the loop with the knot on the out side. See Figure 3. Iron the opening to set the seams. Remove all paper pieces.

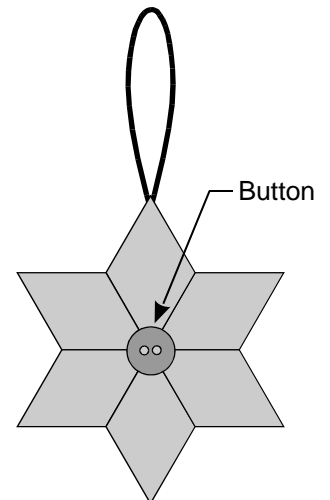


Adding the Stuffing

Turn the star inside out and use the eraser end of a pencil to poke out the corners. Stuff the star with fiber and whip stitch the opening.

Adding the Buttons

Sew one button to each side. Run your thread thru the center of the star so you can pull the buttons snug. When your star is sat on a flat surface, the button should not touch the surface.



Your star stuffy is ready
to be placed on the Christmas tree and enjoyed!
