

Yo-Yo Turkey

For this projects you will need:

Scrap fabric, Peanut in the shell, Needle, quilting thread and Glue gun.

Making the Tail

Make three yo-yos. Cut your fabric in circles sizing: 6-1/2", 4-1/2" and 3-1/2". Tack the yo-yos on top of each other with the large one on the bottom and the small one on the top. Line up the bottom edges of all the yo-yos (not centered).

Making the body

Paint eyes, beak, gobbler and feet on the peanut as show in Figure 1.

Making the Turkey

Use a glue gun to tack the peanut to the yo-yos as show in Figure 1.

Adding the Pin

Sew a pin on the back as shown in Figure 2.

Your Turkey is ready to wear!

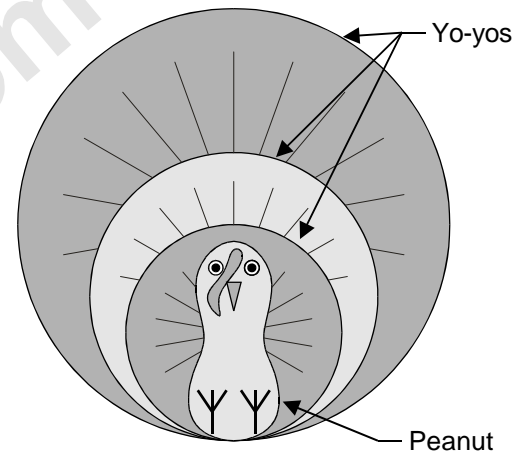

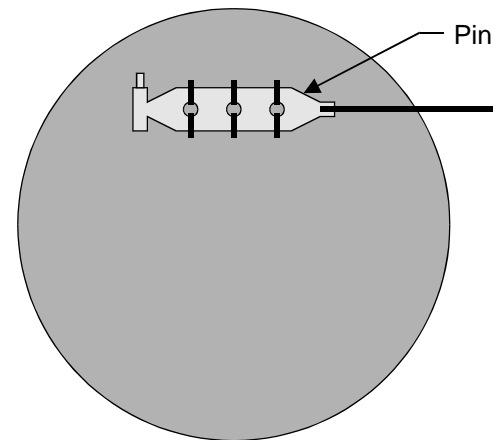
